

Highlights of Egypt with Nile River Cruise (10 days/ 9 Nights)

Day 1:

Arrival Cairo (L, D) HRS: Arrive at Cairo international Airport, meet, assist by our representative HRS Transfer to hotel for check-in with lunch at restaurant on the way 18:30 HRS: Sound & Light show at the Pyramids 20:30 HRS: Dinner at Local Restaurant Overnight at hotel

Day 2:

Cairo (B, L & D) 08:00 HRS: Breakfast at hotel 09:00. HRS: Visit the pyramids of Giza and sphinx, one of the Seven Wonders of the World, continue to visit the papyrus & Perfume factory where you will have some time for shopping. 13:00 HRS: Lunch at restaurant with Indian style food 14:30 HRS Egyptian Museum of Antiquities, which houses one of the world's greatest collections of Egyptian artefacts. It boasts of more than 136,000 artefacts from over five thousand years of Egyptian history. 16:30 HRS: Time to see perfume & Papyrus factory 20:00 HRS: Dinner at local restaurant Overnight at hotel

Day 3:

Cairo / Aswan (B, L&D) 03:00HRS: Breakfast box & check out from the hotel 03:30 HRS: Transfer to Cairo airport to take flight to Aswan 07:30 HRS Arrive Aswan airport with assist by our representative 08:30 HRS: Visit the High Dam & Philae Temple. The Aswan Dam, or more specifically since the 1960s, the Aswan High Dam, is an embankment dam built across the Nile in Aswan, Egypt, between 1960 and 1970. Its significance largely eclipsed the previous Aswan Low Dam initially completed in 1902 downstream. Based on the success of the Low Dam, then at its maximum utilization, construction of the High Dam became a key objective of the government following the Egyptian Revolution of 1952; with its ability to control flooding better, provide increased water storage for irrigation and generate hydroelectricity the dam was seen as pivotal to Egypt's planned industrialization. Like the earlier implementation, the High Dam has had a significant effect on the economy and culture of Egypt. Temple of Philae is currently an island in the reservoir of the Aswan Low Dam downstream of the Aswan Dam and Lake Nasser, Egypt. Philae was originally located near the expansive First Cataract of the Nile in Upper Egypt and was the site of an Egyptian temple complex. 14:30 HRS: Transfer to the 5* Cruise ship (Aswan – Luxor 3 nights) 15:00 HRS: Lunch on-board Dinner & overnight onboard

Day 4:

Aswan – Kom Ombo – Edfu (B, L&D) 05:00 HRS Packed breakfast & start tour to Abu Simbel by coach

The Abu Simbel temples are two massive rock temples at Abu Simbel a village in Nubia, southern Egypt, near the border with Sudan. They are situated on the western bank of Lake Nasser about 230 km southwest of Aswan (about 300 km by road). 12:30 HRS: Lunch onboard the Cruise 13:00 HRS:

Sail to Kom Ombo 16:30 HRS: Visit Temple of Kom Ombo is an unusual double temple in the town of Kom Ombo in Aswan Governorate, Upper Egypt. The building is unique because its 'double' design meant that there were courts, halls, sanctuaries and rooms duplicated for two sets of gods. The southern half of the temple was dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek, god of fertility and creator of the world with Hathor and Khonsu. Meanwhile, the northern part of the temple was dedicated to the falcon god Haroeris, also known as Horus the Elder, along with Tasetnofret (the Good Sister, a special form of Hathor or Tefnet/Tefnut) and Panebtawy (Lord of the Two Lands). The temple is atypical because everything is perfectly symmetrical along the main axis. 18:30 HRS: Sail to Edfu, Dinner & overnight onboard

Day 5:

Edfu – Esna – Luxor (B, L&D) 06:00 HRS: Tea & Coffee break 06:30 HRS: Visit Edfu Temple The Temple of Edfu is an ancient Egyptian temple, located on the west bank of the Nile in Edfu, Upper Egypt. 08:00 HRS: Breakfast on board 08.30 HRS: Sail to Esna, pass the Esna Lock & sail to Luxor 13:00 HRS: Visit the Valley of the Kings, Deir El Bahari and Colossi of Memnon. The valley stands on the west bank of the Nile, opposite Thebes (modern Luxor), within the heart of the Theban Necropolis. The Wadi consists of two valleys, East Valley (where the majority of the royal tombs are situated) and West Valley Dinner & overnight on board

Day 6:

Monday - Cruise – Luxor / Hurghada (B, L&D) 07:00 HRS: Check out from cruise after Breakfast, 08:00 HRS: Karnak & Luxor Temples The Karnak Temple Complex., commonly known as Karnak, comprises a vast mix of decayed temples, chapels, pylons, and other buildings. Luxor Temple is a large Ancient Egyptian temple complex located on the east bank of the Nile River 11:00 HRS: Transfer to Hurghada on private coach with pack lunch 15:30 HRS: Arrive Hurghada & check-in at resort 16:00 HRS: Free at leisure 20:00 HRS: Dinner at resort with open buffet. Overnight at resort

Day 7
